## A note from Pastor Angela

In the months of May and June, there are two very special holidays - Mother's Day and Father's Day. As I write this, I am looking forward with great anticipation to a visit from my parents in a week. My mom will actually be here to celebrate Mother's Day. I'm very excited about their visit. When I mentioned to my mom that they will be here for Mother's Day and so we are going to have to celebrate, her response was, "Well, I'm going to have to bring my little girl who is a little mother a special gift." I was thinking about celebrating my mom and she was thinking about celebrating me as a mom

That's my mom, though. If I had one word to describe my mom it would be self-less. My whole life I have known my mom to sacrifice for her children and her husband. She went without so we could have more. She gets upset every Christmas when her children get her gifts because she feels like we should never give her anything. So, it does not surprise me that she thought about getting me a gift instead of thinking about us celebrating her, as my mom, on that day.

In 1 Thessalonians 1, Paul speaks of how they labored among the people so that many could come to know the Lord. He stated that they served the newly formed church and its band of new Christians as mothers caring for and feeding their children. They shared not only the good news of Christ, but their very lives as well. For Paul, sharing Christ with others was all about sharing his life and taking care of people as a mother takes care of her children.

Isn't that an interesting way to view evangelism? So, when I share the gospel with someone, I am, in effect, becoming their spiritual mother. When I combine that with how my mother sacrificed and gave herself for me, I see that it is, then, my responsibility to nurture their spiritual growth, to be available for them, to share my life for them, to sacrifice what I want in order to help them know Christ. We are all called to be spiritual mothers and spiritual fathers. We are called to share the gift of Jesus Christ with others selflessly because we love people and don't want to see them be separated from God. Then, once someone does accept Christ, we are to feed them from God's Word and care for them, invest in them and help to answer their guestions—just like a mother.

I'm so thankful that I had a mother and a father who both exemplified the love of God so that I could understand it fully. Since not everyone had that same example, it is even more important for us to be their spiritual mothers and fathers. Who are some of your spiritual children? We all need to seek out some spiritual children and then start sacrificially investing in their lives. Then, I can address this to all of us: Happy Mother's Day and Happy Father's Day!


